Recommended April 2013 Drenching trigger levels (guide only)

Mature Age Strongyle epg

150 to 200 epg Borderline *Drench depends on other risk factors (for eg age, condition score, FOO and lambing date)*

< 400 epg Mobs (ie >2-Y-0) drench 95% (leave fattest 5% un-drenched to delay resistance)

400 + epg Drench 100%

2012 drop Lambs

- usually drench promptly when strongyle reach 200 epg to maintain productivity
 - particularly in lighter spring drop weaners
 - delay till 300 epg + if heavier and or aut drop
- require worm exposure to gain host immunity so best practice to delay drenching if under 200 epg but if between 100 – 200 epg will need to monitor frequently to gain host immunity without leaving vulnerable to a check from too many worms particularly 4-7 weeks post break

Comments:

All counts are low which is good news. Suggest re-check lambs in mid-May regardless of weather.

Mature ewes will not need further counts until 6 weeks post autumn break or just prior to lamb commencement whatever comes first.
